Well Done!

Well done to all of the children in Year 2 and Year 6 who sat their SATs tests in May. We are all immensely proud of you and for the effort you all put in. Not only during the week of the assessments, but throughout your time at Stanton.

Whole School Photo and Year 6 Leavers Photo

Our whole school photograph is scheduled for **Monday 12th June** – pray for blue skies and sunshine! Please can all pupils arrive at school wearing their full school uniform on this day. In addition to our whole school photo, the Year 6 leavers will also have a class photo on the same day – having their leavers hoodies and school jumpers in school that day is a good idea.

Year 1 Phonics Screening Check

Year 1 phonics screening checks will take place week commencing **12th June**. All year 1 pupils plus some Year 2 pupils will participate. The assessment can help staff to spot gaps, monitor progress and ensure children are supported effectively.

Year 6 Taster Day at Lady Manners

Our Year 6 pupils, who will be beginning their journey at Lady Manners in September, have two transition days scheduled. The first on **Tuesday June 20th**. Their final transition day will be **July 4th**. Lady Manners should have contacted (or will be contacting) families with further details regarding these days.

The pupils have already had the pleasure of meeting their Head of Year, after Mrs. Hallam visited school on Monday 22nd May. The visit provided a great opportunity for the children to ask lots of questions, and I believe it went some way towards putting their minds at ease. Ensuring our pupils have a smooth transition up to secondary school is important. We will be speaking with the Year 6s regularly about their transition and helping them prepare throughout their final half-term with us. Year 4 Multiplication Check

June 2022 saw the introduction of the Year 4 multiplication times-table check. This is an onscreen assessment consisting of 25 multiplication questions. Pupils will have 6 seconds to answer each question with a 3 second pause between each question. This year's checks will take place week commencing **June 26th**.
