PE

PE this term will take place on **Thursdays**. To save time and ensure we make the most of our school day, we ask that children arrive at school wearing their school PE kits – white Stanton-in Peak t-shirt, blue or black shorts and trainers. School (or plain navy) jumpers and navy joggers can be worn over the top of pupils' PE kits on chilly days. School staff will also spend Thursdays in their kit.

Forest Schools

Forest Schools. Forest Schools is an integral part of our school and plays an important role in ensuring our pupils' health and wellbeing are at the forefront of everything we do. This year, Forest Schools sessions will take place on **Friday Afternoons**. Children in reception through to Year 6 will be required to arrive at school wearing their 'Forest Schools kit'.

Forest Schools Kit: it is important that children are dressed appropriately for Forest Schools. Long-sleeved tops and trousers are essential to help protect from brambles and branches. Suitable footwear (hiking books or wellies) as well as a change of shoes for the journey home are also important. We encourage parents and pupils to check the forecast and use it to inform their decisions regarding sun-hats, sun-cream, coats, wooly hats and waterproofs.

Location: as well as our school site, we are lucky enough to have two fantastic locations for our Forest Schools sessions. One site is a short walk past the cricket pitch to the woods, the other – slightly further away on the moor and requires children to walk up and out of the village (the infant class will not use the moor for their Forest Schools sessions this term).

Swimming

This half-term, the Year 5s and 6s will resume their swimming lessons at Bakewell Swimming Pool. Their first of five lessons will begin on Wednesday 21st September. As in previous years, pupils will need their swimsuit/shorts, a towel, goggles (optional) and a swim hat (swim hats can be purchased from the Bakewell pool for a small fee). Miss Prystupa and the children are picked up at 1pm and travel by coach to the pool. We rely on parent volunteers to accompany the class each week. Any parents who are available on Wednesday afternoons and would like to volunteer, please fill in the swimming rota attached to this newsletter.

Work on the allotment has begun and school staff, along with James and Lucinda, are excited to get started with the new project, which aims to promote the understanding and importance of growing and eating organic fruits and vegetables. Throughout our autumn term, children across the school will work in the allotment, discovering: ways compost green waste; how to grow fresh fruit and vegetables; as well as what to harvest and when. The allotment will also present opportunities for pupils to observe plant life cycles.

Parenthub/Parentpay and Dinner Money

Please ensure your dinner money payments are up to date Parentpay.

From September pupil paid dinners are £2.30 (price increase of 10p).

Mrs Rimmer is currently updating the pupil database and in the next couple of weeks last year's Y6s will be taken off and any new starters will be added to Parentpay and Parenthub (the texting service). This may take a few days. The new Year 3 pupils will no longer receive UFSMs and will now be charged by DCC for dinners (£2.30 per day). A letter will be sent out reminding new payers how to log on to Parentpay/Password reminder. Currently Infant parents will only need to use Parentpay to pay for school trips – set up details will follow.


