Dear parents and members of our school community,

The children have all returned to school after the Easter break looking refreshed and ready for all that our summer term has to offer. One look at the *Dates for Your Dairy* section will highlight just how busy our summer term is. There is lots to look forward to.

### Easter Fair

Thank you to our PTFA who put a tremendous amount of effort and energy into to Easter fair last month. It was great to see so many people in school and it was clear that everyone enjoyed engaging with the different activities. It felt like the perfect way to end our spring term.

Thank you all for attending and for supporting our school. As well as raising £170.59 for our PTFA fund, the Year 5 and 6 class were extremely pleased to raise the £100 they needed to protect an acre of rainforest from deforestation – thank you for supporting them.

### Christian Value

## Inspirational Athlete and Bunting Cup

**Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> May** is a sport-filled day at Stanton. Whilst our school football team is in Matlock representing our school in the annual tournament – the Bunting Cup, the rest of the school will be treated to a special visit from an inspirational athlete.

Throughout the day, each class will take part in a series of exercises alongside an inspirational athlete. Once each class has participated in the activity, they will then join the athlete for a motivational assembly where the athlete will give a talk to the children with important messages around resilience and growth mindset. The children will then be given the chance to ask the athlete any questions they may have. **Children are asked to wear their school PE kits on Thursday and Friday that week.**

To fund the day, our pupils are being asked to gain sponsorship to take part in a physical challenge alongside the athlete. The company (Great Athletes) deduct £3.50 per child participating in the fitness circuit on the day which goes towards covering some of their costs of running the scheme. The rest of the money raised is split as follows:

60% - Our school – this will be used to spend on sports equipment.

40% - Great Athletes – to help to fund the athletes we work with and the scheme

They will require:

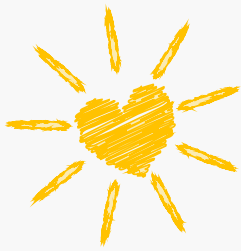
